Open Access Publishing

Open access is a publishing model for scholarly communication that makes research information available to readers at no cost, as opposed to the traditional subscription model in which readers have access to scholarly information by paying a subscription (usually via libraries).

Open Access Publishing:

Gold Open Access ensures that the final version of an article is freely and permanently accessible for everyone on the publisher's platform, immediately after publication. This type of open access usually requires paying APC (**Article Processing Charge***).

Hybrid Open Access: Hybrid open access journals are subscription-based journals that allow authors to choose open access at the article level. An APC applies if an author chooses the open access option.

*APC: The costs associated with open access publishing are covered by article publication charges (APCs), usually these high cost publication page charges are paid by the Author's institution

What is Transformative Agreement?

Transformative agreements are contracts negotiated between institutions and publishers that transform the business model underlying scholarly publishing towards a fully open access model. They represent a shift away from a subscription-only model to one which covers both subscription payments and article publication charges.

Transformative Agreements @ IPR



IPR has singed a **Transformative Agreement (TA)** with Institute of Physics Publishing (IOPP).

This "Read & Publish" agreement allows IPR to access the complete IOP Journal collection and Publish upto 10 articles in IOP fully-open access journals including the journal "Nuclear Fusion" without any Article Processing Charges (APC)

Transformative Agreements @ IPR
